Rules of conduct:

- Attire: All students are encouraged to dress modestly and decently.
 WHAT IS ACCEPTABLE GENERAL DRESS?
- Ladies: TOPS at least one (1) inch strap widths, of a length to still cover the midriff with arms raised over head, loose-fitting (as to distort natural curvature) and with neck openings no more than two (2) inches below the collar bone as to adequately cover cleavage. SKIRTS/SHORTS – should be longer than finger-tip length with arms fully extended to side. Undergarments should not be exposed.
- Gentlemen: TOPS shirts that do not reveal arm pit areas (i.e. low-cut sides).
 PANTS/SHORTS should be worn to fit just below the top of the pelvic bone.
 Undergarments should not be exposed.
- Children/student behavior

We understand that illnesses and emergencies come up, however we ask that you take your commitment seriously, as this is a volunteer group that is funded solely by the leaders and volunteer instructors involved.
